Obituary



It is with sadness we report the death of Dr. John Clark Love Gibson, who died on 17th November 2008, in Edinburgh aged 78. He was minister of Newmachar Church from 1959 - 1962, which was his first and only Charge. He was appointed Lecturer in Hebrew and semitic languages at New College on the Mound, Edinburgh. He remained at the University of Edinburgh from 1962 until his retirement in 1994, was promoted Reader (1973) and then Professor in 1987.
